Hello! We are USA Girl Scouts Overseas Troop 5, and Boy Scouts of America Cub Scout Pack 5. We have 8 girls and 3 boys in our group, mostly Americans, and we live in Atyrau, Kazakhstan, at the mouth of the Ural River, at the north end of the Caspian Sea. The Ural River is considered the border between Europe and Asia. There are big oilfields nearby and fishing and harvesting caviar are also important here. The river freezes in the winter and people ice fish on it. There are not very many trees here but there is grass. This postcard is of some Kazakh dancers at Atyrau City Day (in October) in the public square by the mosque. The national language is Kazakh, but most people in our area also speak Russian. In Kazakhstan, the camel herders live in round houses called "yurts", but we live in regular houses and apartments as do most Kazakhs.
